There will be an amphitheater that's 2.5 acres in Stadium Trace. Everlee Development is going next to Ross Bridge and will have over 2,800 new homes. Hoover will annex that land, and it brings up conversations about adding a 3rd high school in Hoover. It will be the size of Ross Bridge, maybe larger. A new interstate exit will be put on I-459 to connect Morgan Rd and Ross Bridge Pkwy. Halo is a new business incubator in the Office Tower of the Galleria complex. It helps new businesses get off the ground. The Galleria is 90% leased. The ultimate thinking is to tear out the Macy's and Sears building and turn it into an outdoor shopping area. Paul mentioned that Hoover City Schools is currently looking for a new superintendent. Toni Bast spoke as well. She is 30 days in with her role as President of Chamber of Commerce.
