Dr. Trimble shared this message about Banks Academy:

The focus is on educating the whole child. Students come from all over Birmingham. Current enrollment is 130 scholars. Every day they get a chance to hear the Word of God. New etiquette class added this year. Move from a mindset of entitlement to a mindset of enlightenment. Offer athletics, including a new volleyball team. Students matriculate to 2-year and 4-year colleges, and the military. Each year, there are several baptisms of students giving their lives to Christ. There is a belief a difference is being made not only at Banks, but also in Birmingham and Jefferson County. Now have grades 6-12. All are invited to the student banquet on April 23rd.
