Richard grew up in Minneapolis and started his career in radio on December 23, 1983 in Southern California. He is 60 years old and has been happily divorced for 10 years, with 1 daughter and 3 grandchildren.

- Questions he's often asked: Q. "How did you get into radio?'
 - A. Either by luck or curse, it's all he's ever wanted to do since age 10. Went to Brown Institute, a radio broadcasting school. It was a 10-month course which taught the basics of broadcasting. He "burned the boats" and decided radio is the only job he's ever going to do by learning no other skills.
- Q. "How did you get into talk radio?"
- A. If you succeed or fail, it's all on you. Ratings are all that matter.

These days, 3 or 4 broadcasting companies (i.e. Cumulus and iHeart) own almost all radio stations these days. Live and local, daily talk programming could be a movement in radio.

Celebrities are really just regular people with really cool jobs. One of the famous people Richard has met is Brian Wilson of the Beach Boys. Some super nice famous folks he's met are Donald Rumsfeld and Condoleeza Rice. Simon Peg, a British comedian, was a terrible interview.
